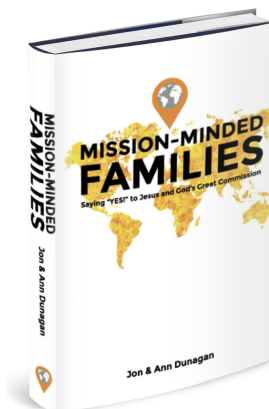

*What typical life-goals do many parents strive for?  
Have you ever attended a "thought-provoking" funeral?  
In the Bible, what's the most important "End" to consider?  
How did Jesus "See the End" as He lived His life on earth?  
What is one change you could make in your family priorities  
to live with more focus on the "End" and eternity?*

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**Key #4:  
AIM YOUR ARROWS**
